Born in Florence on May 10, 1962.

Received a high school diploma in 1981 from the Liceo Scientifico Castelnuovo in Florence,

Studied photography at Fortman Studios School in Florence and obtained a diploma in 1985.

Professional photographer since 1986.

In 1986, he began an on-going collaboration as a photographer with Centro Moda di Firenze in the international fashion shows of Pitti Immagine (Pitti Uomo, Pitti Bimbo Pitti Casa ecc.)

Since 1989 he is the official photographer of the press office of Pitti Immagine.

From 1987-1990 he taught photography at Fortman Studios.

In 1989-1990, he taught photography at the Art school "Art ... è" in Florence.

Since 1991, he has worked as a laboratory technician in the Department of Photography at Syracuse University in Florence and since 2001 he is the photographer of the events organized by the University.

Since January 2000, He is a photography teacher at Syracuse University in Florence.

Since 2001 he is the official photographer of the press office of Stazione Leopolda in Florence.

He frequently works with such diverse international fashion magazines as the Spanish "Divos" and "Ninsmoda" and the German "Textil Wirtschaft" and "Textil Mitteilungen" as well as the American monthly "Robb Report".

In 2003 he has realized the entire catalogue of "Techlà", a hi-tech accessories factory, working exclusively with digital media in studio.

He has realized photo reportages for many wine factories in the Chianti area and for the "Consorzio del Chianti Colli Fiorentini".

He also works with the theatre company "Macchine di Bosco" as a still photographer and assistant set designer.

He works mainly with digital equipment but also with traditional film cameras, both 35mm and medium format.

He has a good knowledge of computers (especially Mac) and of graphic applications like Photoshop and QuarkXPress.

He has participated in many group photography exhibitions.

In March 2007 he participated in an exhibit at Santa Clara University.
